# Hagley Road SPRINT Project Approval

#### **Purpose of the Report**

To update the Supervisory Board on the decision made by the Greater Birmingham and Solihull Local Enterprise Partnership (GBSLEP) Programme Delivery Board on the 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2017, in relation to Local Growth Fund (LGF) funding for the Hagley Road SPRINT scheme, to the value of £4.7m.

#### Background

 The Hagley Road SPRINT transport scheme was granted entry into the LGF programme in 2015. It is promoted by Transport for West midlands (TfWM) (previously Centro) and Birmingham City Council (BCC). TfWM will be the grant recipient of the fund and also the Delivery Agent for the scheme.
